#### Red & Blue Clothes Day—Friday 5th February

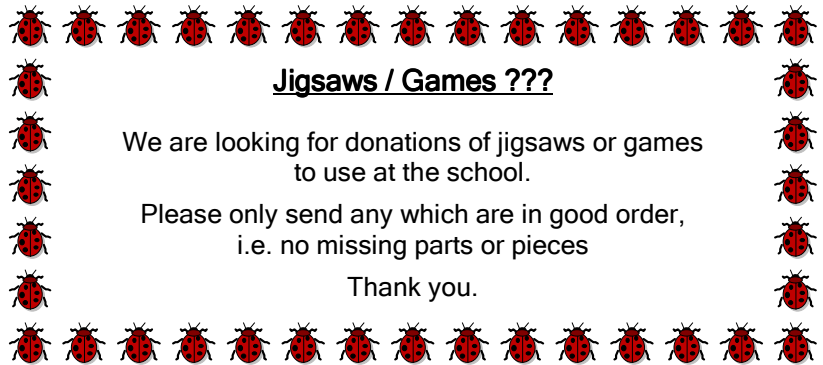
The children held a Mufty Day wearing red and blue clothes, as these are the colours of the country's national flag, to raise money to help the people of Haiti.
